Recycling Facility Opens July 2nd

The recycling facility officially opens Tuesday July 2nd. Operating hours will be every Tuesday & Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. excluding Holidays. The City will no longer pick up recycling, it must be dropped off at the new facility. Exceptions will be made for those who are physically unable to get to the facility with an approved Doctor's note. Recycling bags will be available for pick-up at the facility when you drop off your recycleables. They will no longer be available at City Hall. County recycling will be accepted on a trial basis.
