

**WATER & SEWER COMMITTEE MEETING
SEPTEMBER 1, 2009**

The Water and Sewer Committee of the Washington City Council met on Tuesday, September 1, 2009, at 11 AM in the Council Chambers of City Hall to discuss funding sources for the Water Plant Re-Hab projects. Mayor W. E. Burns presided.

Present were: Mayor Burns, Council members Mahoney and Pope, City Administrator Eskew, City Clerk Danner, John Scott, David Jenkins and Charles Welch of Stevenson & Palmer Engineers.

After being notified by GEFA that the City of Washington, Georgia, would not receive federal stimulus funding, Mr. Welch has contacted GEFA, and has received information on a GEFA \$6.2 million loan with \$500,000 forgiven at 0% interest for twenty years.

The committee concurred with proceeding with this loan proposal.
