

WORK SESSION
April 6, 2020

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Washington, Georgia, Work Session on Monday, April 6, 2020, beginning at 5:00 PM at the Council Chamber at City Hall. Mayor William deGolian presided.

On motion by Armour, Second by Wagner to go into Executive Session.

Administrator topics of discussion: Property Tax Write-offs, 2020 City Budget, Budget Cuts.

Service Delivery Strategy was discussed also.

On motion by Mahoney, Second by Wagner to adjourn Executive Session at 6:41 PM. On motion by Mahoney, Second by Wagner to sign the affidavit acknowledging closing Executive Session matter.

Work Session resumed – Administrator deBin explain to the Council that he would like to remove the \$150 balance some of the customers are leaving on the bill. Administrator deBin will have a preliminary review to make changes in order to try to balance the budget. Question arose; will the deposit for utilities increase to offset those customers who are leaving bills.

Service Delivery Strategy was brought up again. Mayor deGolian stated that there had been a hand delivered letter to Chairman Moore to discuss negotiations and Chairman Moore have not touched base with him.

Hill inquired about the old Georgia Task building on Hospital Drive. What was it used for; the damages.

Cullars stated that the Public works Department need to clean up the Whitehall area.
