New Recycling Facility Opening Soon

The City of Washington is happy to announce that the new recycling facility will be open soon! This project has been in the works for over 6 months and will be fully operational by July 3rd. Customers will be able to drop off their recycling on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The facility is located on Norman Street



Across the road from Smith Farm Supply and next to the Public Works warehouse. There is no cost to drop off your recyclables, and the City will allow County residents to drop off at this location as well. **The City will NO LONGER pick up County recycling behind the Court House**, so please be sure to bring your recycling to the facility to ensure it is processed properly. If you would like to recycle but are physically unable to bring your recycling to the facility, you can call City Hall at 706-678-3277 and put in a request to have your items picked up on Thursday mornings. You must have a note from your doctor concerning your disability, or you must be over the age of 75 and no longer able to drive to qualify.
