

**CALLED MEETING  
APRIL 11, 2018**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Washington, Georgia, held a Called Meeting on Wednesday, April 11, 2018, beginning at 12:30 PM, in the Council Chambers of City Hall to discuss the proposed Community Garden. Mayor Ames Barnett presided.

Present were Mayor Barnett and council members Armour, Armour and Scarborough. Also present were City Administrator Bailey, City Clerk Danner, City Attorney Fleming and Community Development Director Dill.

Mayor Barnett advised that following the regular meeting of council on April 9, that he had learned that council member Travis Armour had abstained from voting on the proposed community garden because he did not want it to interfere with any current or proposed URA projects. Community Development Director Marcus Dill had advised that the proposed garden would not hinder any proposed URA projects.

City Administrator Bailey advised that the garden would be open during daylight hours only; that gardening squares would be available in different sizes but that all size squares would have a \$25 deposit charge which will be refunded at the end of the gardening season if the square is cleaned after use. Gardening tools will be available for use to those who participate in the project, with special kid size tools also available.

Bailey also noted that all council members were notified on March 22, 2018, by email of the proposed Community Garden project.

On motion by R. Armour, second by Scarborough, council voted 4 to 0 to continue with the Community Garden project for 2018.

On motion by Scarborough, second by R. Armour, council approved adjournment at 12:45 PM.
