

**COMMITTEE MEETINGS
NOVEMBER 5, 2009**

The Mayor and Council Committees met on Thursday, November 5, 2009, beginning at 8:30 AM in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Mayor W.E. Burns presided.

8:30 AM: WATER/SEWER: Present were Mayor Burns, Council members Mahoney and Pope. Also present were City Administrator Eskew, City Clerk Danner, Roy Mason and John Scott.

City Administrator Eskew advised that the OMI contract price did not change for 2010 and that the GEFA paperwork is in for the water plant rehab work; 30 day advertisement for bids should begin in mid-November.

Water and Sewer distribution has no capital item request for the 2010 budget; however, some of the equipment is beginning to show some age. Utility Service Company also held contract prices for 2010 on the water tanks.

9 AM: PUBLIC WORKS: Present were Mayor Burns, Council members Eaton and Mahoney. Also present were City Administrator Eskew, City Clerk Danner and Bobby Mills.

Mayor Burns requested that Street department repairs and maintenance 2010 budget be increased to \$60,000. City Administrator Eskew noted that site repairs for the 2010 budget shows an increase of \$25,000 over 2009 for a total of \$75,000. Capital items requested in 2010 budget are a backhoe and two used trucks for the Street Department and a smaller zero-turn mower for the Cemetery Department.

Sanitation Department 2010 Capital Item budget includes one Kubota scooter. Sanitation also includes a \$1.00 increase per garbage customer.
