

**PUBLIC HEARING
MARCH 9, 2009 – SOUTHEAST REDEV. PLAN**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Washington, Georgia, held a Public Hearing on Monday, March 9, 2009, 5:15 PM in the Council Chambers of City Hall for the purpose of authorizing the writing of a Southeast Redevelopment Plan. Mayor W.E. Burns presided.

Present were Mayor Burns, council members Avery, Barnett, Eaton and Pope. Also present were City Administrator Eskew, City Clerk Danner, and City Attorney representative Stephen Brown. Council members Cullars and Mahoney were not in attendance.

Visitors included: Barbara Bacon, Ann Floyd of the CSRA RDC and Kip Burke of the News Reporter.

City Administrator Eskew advised that David Jenkins will write a Southeast Urban Redevelopment Plan for an area located between East Robert Toombs Avenue and Ashley Avenue. This area was re-zoned some years ago to P-1. Once the plan is written, developers may apply for re-vitalization area status.
